- 2) Does it invite deeper conversation and thinking?
- 3) Does it promote the Democrat Party and ideals in a positive manner?

Some Does and Don'ts:

- \_\_\_\_\_ If you used copyrighted material did you get the owner's permission?
- \_\_\_\_\_ If you "spoke" for other individuals or organizations, did you get their permission?
- \_\_\_\_\_ If it is a news event, did you include the relevant details of who, what, where, and when?
- \_\_\_\_\_ Did you include pictures that may help explain the post?
- If the picture(s) were not taken by you, did you receive permission by the photographer to use them on the tillcodems.org website?
- If there are photos of someone other than you, did you receive permission from the individual(s) to put their photo on the tillcodems.org website?
- \_\_\_\_\_ If it is a story or a news event, did you check to make sure it is factual and the truth?
- \_\_\_\_\_ If it is an opinion, did you explain your opinion with examples and truth?
- \_\_\_\_\_ There is no name calling, racist/biased language, or promoting of harm to another person or organization.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Did you sign your name? Include your picture?
- The Tillamook Democrat Party Communications Committee is responsible for all content on the website. They have the final say in what it posted? Did you submit it to them for review?
